In response to the May 7 tornado in Kalamazoo County, United Way of South Central Michigan and Kalamazoo Community Foundation activated their Disaster Relief and Community Urgent Relief funds, respectively. Grantmaking decisions are made weekly by review teams composed of UWSCMI and KZCF staff members and volunteers.
