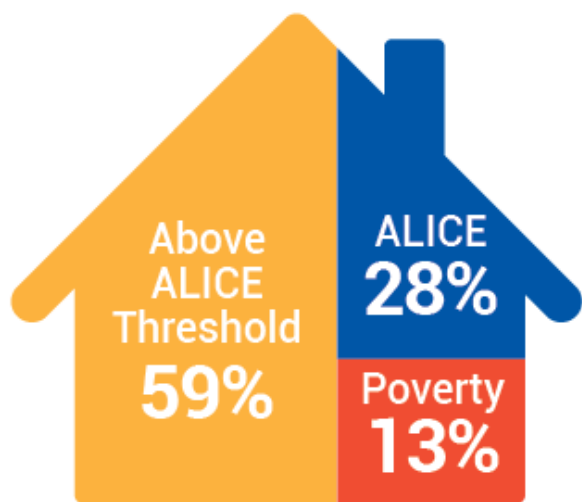
Our Mission

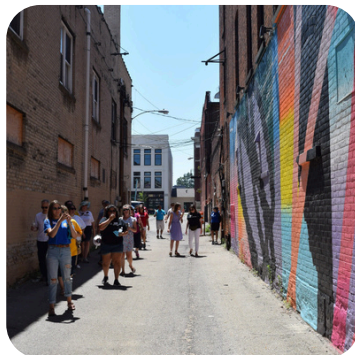
