Small Business Support

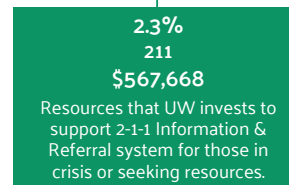
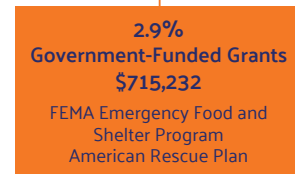
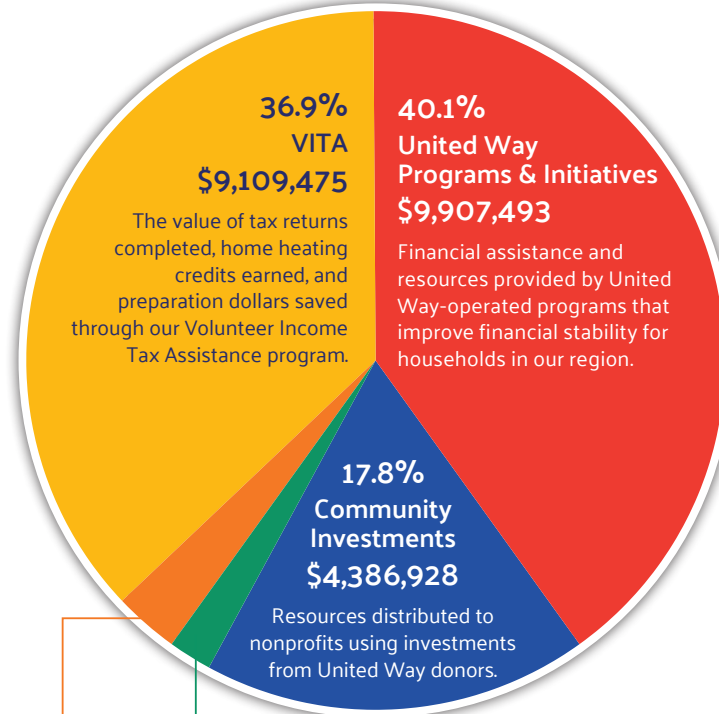
