In March, a devastating fire tore through a Jackson apartment building, claiming one life, injuring several others, and displacing 70 families who were without a place to call home. In the wake of this tragedy, United Way of South Central Michigan activated its Disaster Relief Fund to help our community respond.

Dollars raised are granted to local nonprofits on the ground providing immediate and long-term support – from collection of basic needs items and financial assistance via gift cards to recovery assistance. Grantees to date are: Jackson Strength Network, Community Action Agency, and Our Neighbor's Keeper.
